1. Bratislava Historical City Center Walking Tour

2. Bratislava Musical History Walking Tour

Pressburg, later known as Pozsony and in 20th century as Bratislava, has rich musical history. The early information about the musical life of Bratislava is captured since medieval time.

3. Visit of Slovak National Gallery exhibitions

Slovak National Gallery, in Slovak Slovenská Národná Galéria, is a network of galleries in Slovakia. In Bratislava it is situated in Esterházy Palace (*Esterházyho palác*) and the Water Barracks (*Vodné kasárne*) which are adjacent to each other. The buildings were reconstructed for the purposes of the gallery in the 1950s and a modern extension was added in the 1970s. In this century the main building was closed. After a long and challenging reconstruction, it was finally opened on 11 December 2022. The Slovak National Gallery is currently curating Collection of Gothic Art, Collection of Baroque Art and Collection of 19th Century Art that are gradually installed.
